Spanish Police dismantles the structure of recruitment and indoctrination DAESH

In the Balearic Islands

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USPA NEWS - The Spanish Police arrested on Tuesday in Palma de Mallorca, the capital of the Balearic Islands in the Mediterranean, a person of Moroccan nationality, in an operation that has been neutralized the structure of indoctrination, radicalization, recruiting and sending fighters of the DAESH.

Through social networks, the detainee made an intense activity of diffusion of doctrinal message and the operating strategy of the terrorist organization. The investigated was a prominent and decisive role in maintaining virtual groupings of radical jihadist character, which were structured into groups with clearly differentiated functions, all under their supervision, active in two types of groups. One of them focused on the search for profiles on social networks that show permeability to terrorist recruitment.

Once selected, the virtual recruiter contaminated with the very radical messages, eliminating those who were not receptive to them, focusing only on that at this stage, responded positively to doctrinal stimuli recruiter. Once he have chosen the most suitable profiles, it is passed to a third stage in which the investigation will determine whether the purpose was the concert and conspiracy to carry out terrorist actions.

In the second group plays an important role in the dynamic and controller, directing its efforts to the formation of a small contingent to travel next to Iraq or Syria in order to fight in the ranks of the terrorist organization DAESH. At the lectured and advised members on how to proceed to avoid detection by the Police and the Spanish Civil Guard on their trip.

The arrested had such determination to move to the area of “< conflict where, in what he considered a necessary training for participation in operational actions, were subjected to harsh physical training, besides showing interest in joining a military organization the purpose of completing their training. In order that the displacement of the contingent recruited to Syria or Iraq did not suffer unforeseen, the detainee had established a network of contacts with members of the terrorist organization DAESH, able to facilitate the transition to the territories dominated by the terrorist organization.

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
